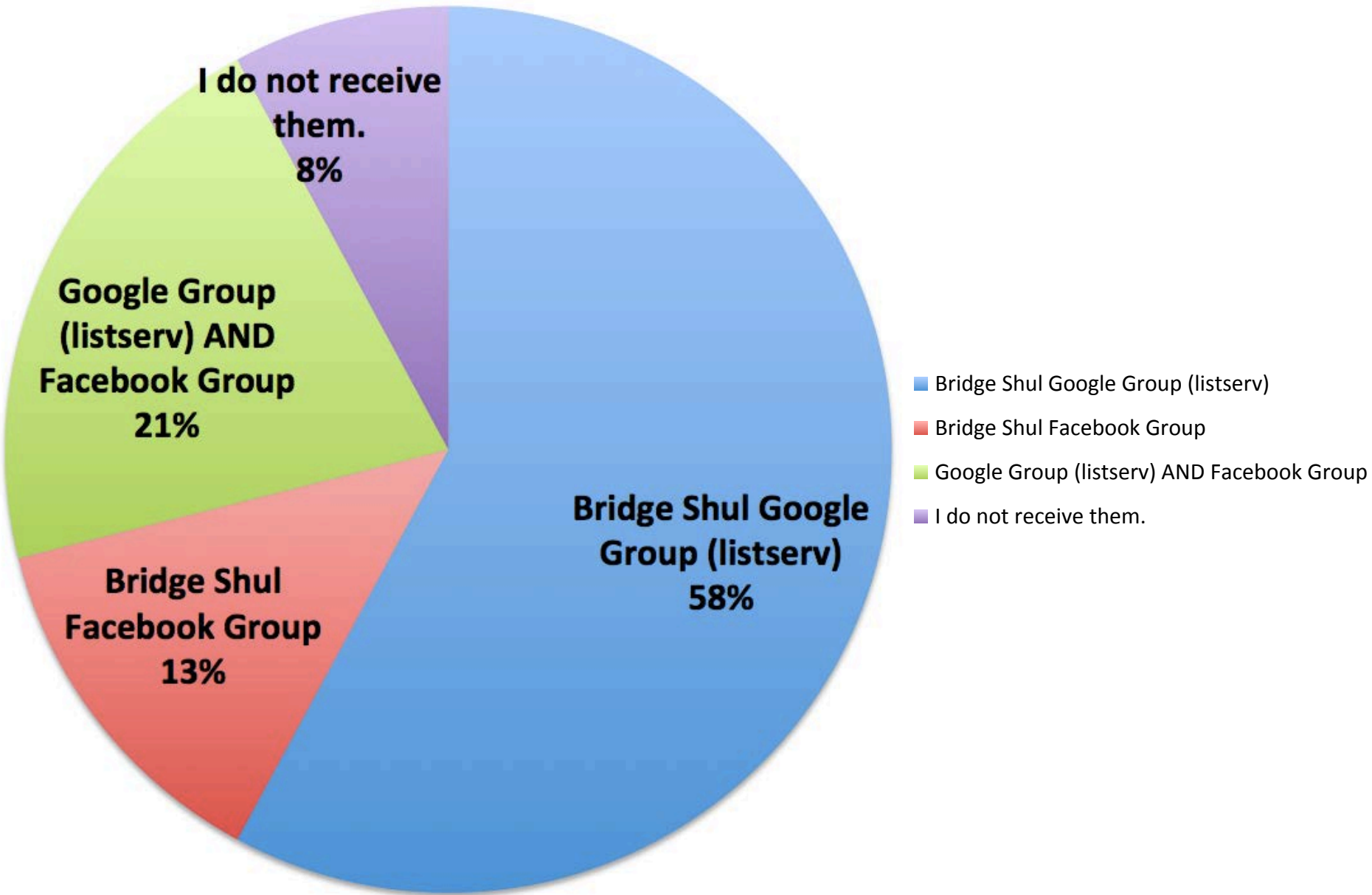
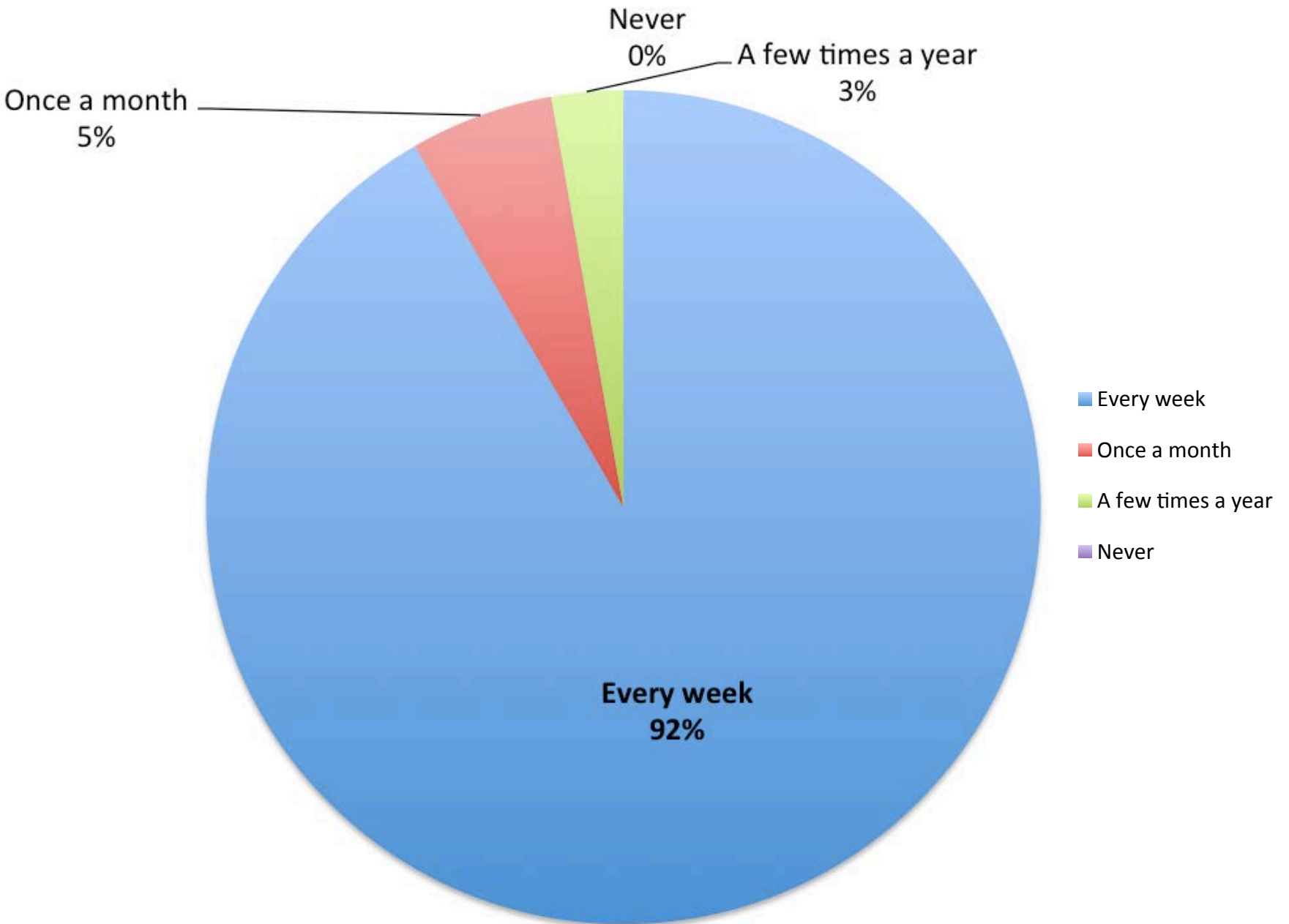


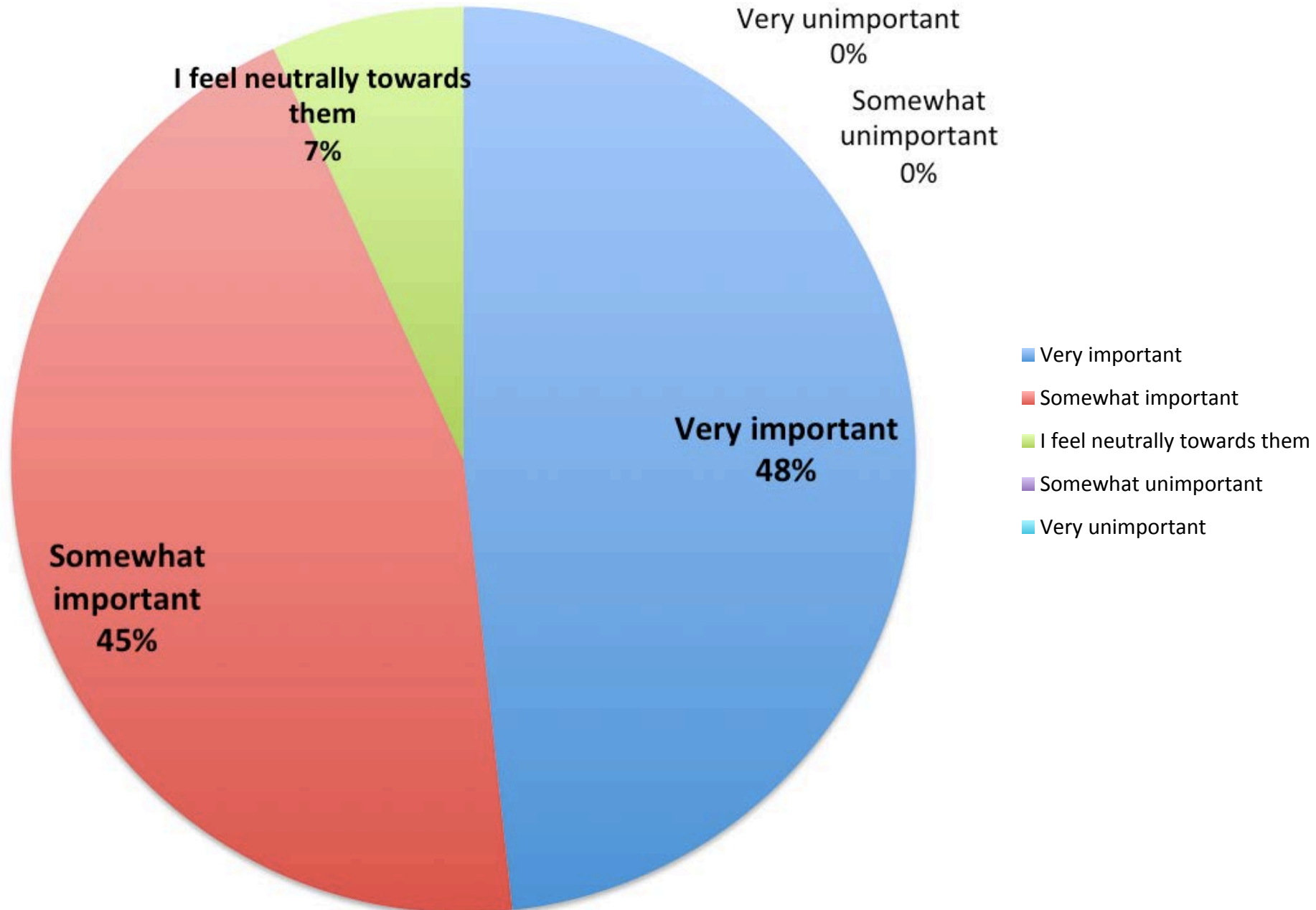
1. Which of the following ways do you receive Washington Heights Congregation/The Bridge Shul's weekly written announcements?



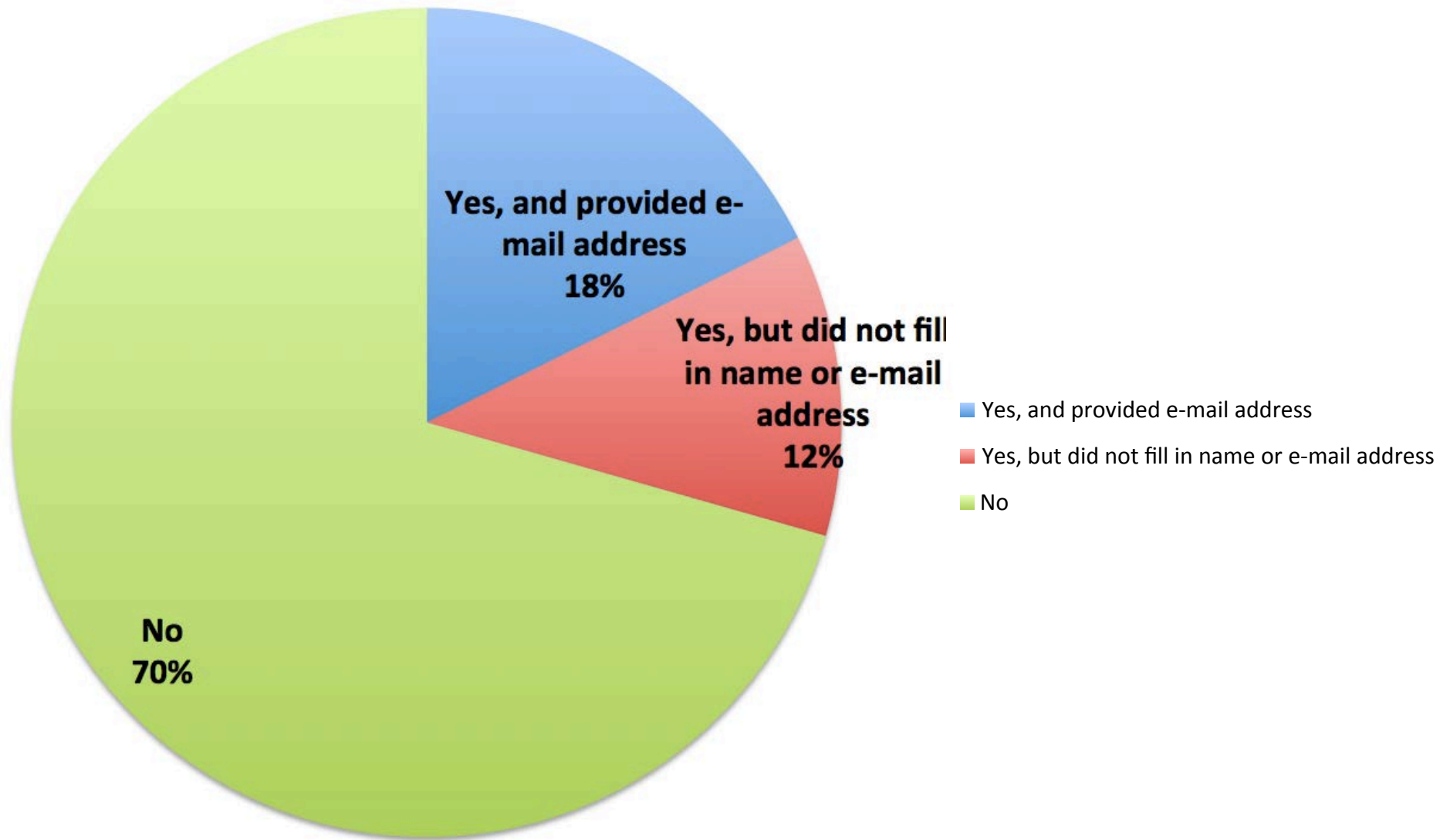
2. How frequently do you actually look at them?

4. Are you willing to help produce weekly written announcements?

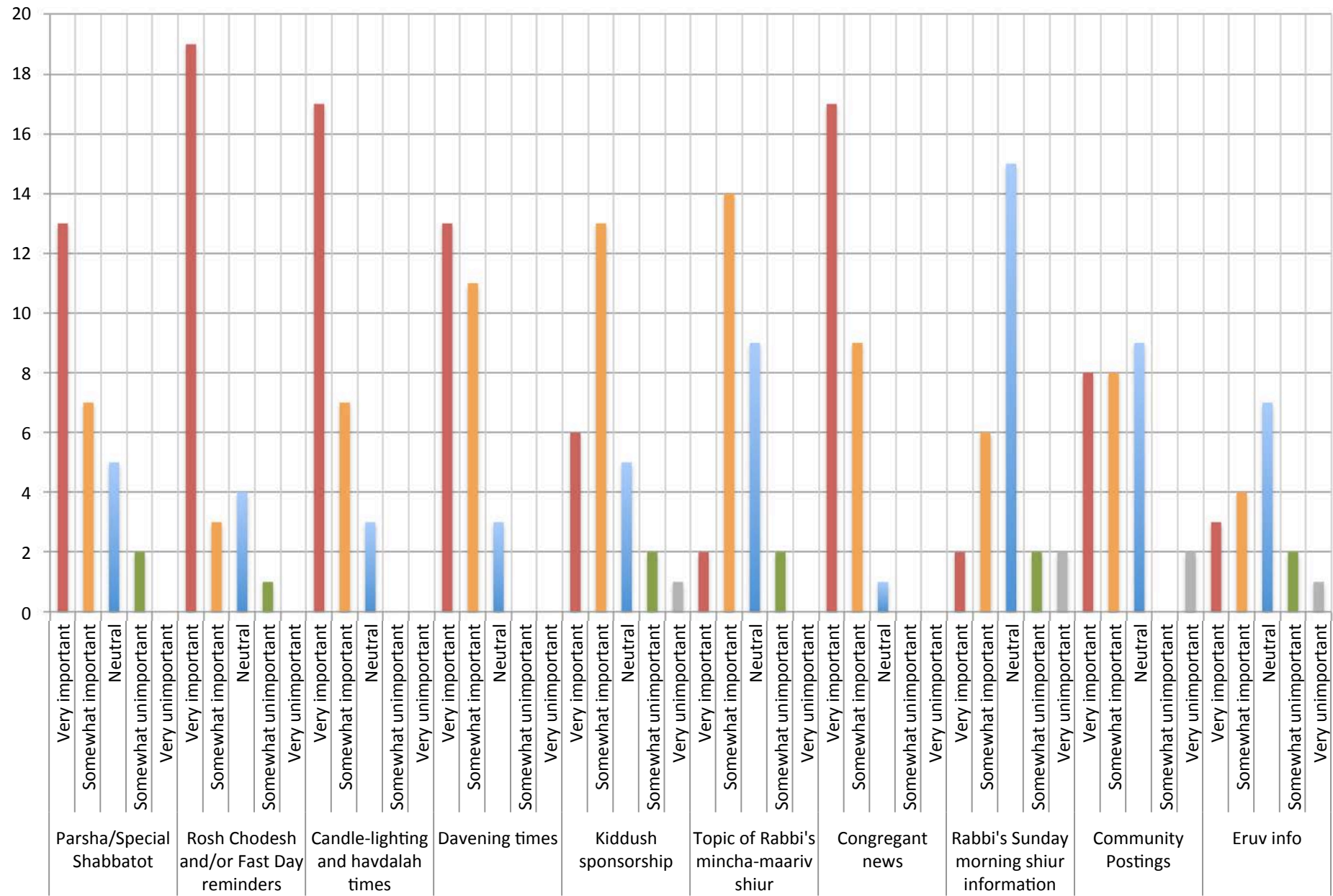
