To Play:

- 1) Place the domino pieces face-down. Shuffle.
- 2) Each player gets seven dominoes to start with.
- 3) In most games, only the open ends of the layout of dominoes can be used, an end is open when it has no other tile connected to it.
- 4) A tile can only be placed if they have a tile in their hand that corresponds to a tile on the table. If a player cannot make a move, then he/she must take a tile from the pile. If the pile is empty, the player simply loses their turn.
- 5) A game ends in one of two ways. Either:
 - when a player has played all his/her tiles or
 - the game is blocked. This occurs when no player is able to add any tiles to the layout.
 In this scenario, there is no winner.
